WINEMAKING NOTES

Hand-harvested from young vines, planted in 2014. Fermented wild in stainless-steel and left on skins for 31 days. After pressing, the wine was aged in two biodynamic barrels from cooperage Boutes: Sol, or soleil, designed to maximize tension and restrain tannins; and, Luna, or lune, made from wood felled according to the lunar calendar. The wines were blended to create a balanced wine that can cellar for 15+ years.
